The XXI International Forum of Psychoanalysis welcomes all IFPS members to submit proposals for individual papers and/or a panel representing papers from your society that address the XXI Forum topic.

Proposals should be between 300-500 words. Individual papers will be 20 minutes. Panel presentations will consist of max 4-5 papers (20 minutes each) with an overview of the panel and individual abstracts. Abstracts should be send to Cristina Nunes, forumxxi.papers@gmail.com

The **Benedetti-Conci Award**, for best paper by a candidate from an IFPS society will be given at the Closing of the XIX Forum. The award is \$1000 USA DOLLARS. The paper must have to do with the topic of the Forum and will be evaluated by a specifically appointed commission. The winning paper will be published in the IFPS journal. Abstracts (300-500 words) indicating submission to **Benedetti-Conci Award for IFPS Candidate 2020** before the title should be send to António Alvim, forumxxi.candidates@gmail.com
